

Le Chateau de Versailles awaits you in all its grandeur as you return to the time period of the most famous French kings and queens.

Upon arrival in the town of Versailles, we will ride to the famous city market to shop for our picnic supplies (not included). Then, we'll cruise through the chateau's enormous gardens along a network of fantastic trails and tree-lined paths to visit both the Petit & Grand Trianons. Next, it's on to our picnic at the end of the Grand Canal where we'll settle down in the exact spot where Kings Louis XIV, XV and XVI dined as they marveled at their house at the far end.

After lunch we'll continue through the gardens and enter the chambers of the chateau itself. See the room where Marie Antoinette's guards were killed as they protected her from the mob at the beginning of the Revolution. Walk through the breathtaking Hall of Mirrors where King Louis greeted guests, and centuries later the Armistice was signed to end World War I.
